UC Law SF students may pursue a joint degree while attending UC Law SF. To be eligible for the program, students must:

- complete the first year curriculum at UC Law SF with a 2.50 GPA or better
- be admitted to a graduate program in a law related discipline

Once approved students must complete 5 full-time semesters *and* 74 units in residence (including *all* graduation requirements). Upon conferral of your graduate degree and receipt of an official transcript, UC Law SF will credit you with one semester of residence and transfer 12 units of credit from the other program. If the graduate program will reciprocate, you can save a full year of coursework between the two schools.

Complete this form and submit to the Registrar's Office along with a copy of your letter of admission to an accredited graduate program and a written statement of objectives, proposed curriculum and dates of attendance at each institution.
