The [University of California College of the Law, San Francisco](#) was established by statute in 1878. While the College maintains a close affiliation with the University of California, it is an independent institution. Formerly known as UC Hastings, the College became the University of California College of the Law, San Francisco – or UC Law SF – on Jan. 1, 2023, after AB 1936 was signed into law. UC Law SF is the oldest law school in the United States west of the Rockies.
