

## **Canvas platform security incident, UC Law SF data not affected**

The College has been made aware of a security incident affecting the Canvas platform at other universities. This is an issue affecting many institutions nationwide, but the University of California has informed UC Law SF that the College's data was not compromised.

We are monitoring updates from Instructure, the company that owns Canvas. Updates from Instructure are posted on its [status page](#). IT services will monitor the situation and we will share new information on this page as needed.

Instructure reported that outside actors accessed Canvas information, but they no longer have access. Information that may have been involved includes names, email addresses, student ID numbers, and messages exchanged in Canvas. There is no evidence at this time that passwords, birthdates, government IDs, or financial information were compromised.

While current information is that the College was not affected, as with any security incident be careful of phishing attempts, including unexpected messages that seem to come from UC Law SF. The College will never ask for passwords, Social Security numbers, birthdates, or bank account information through email, text, or phone calls.
